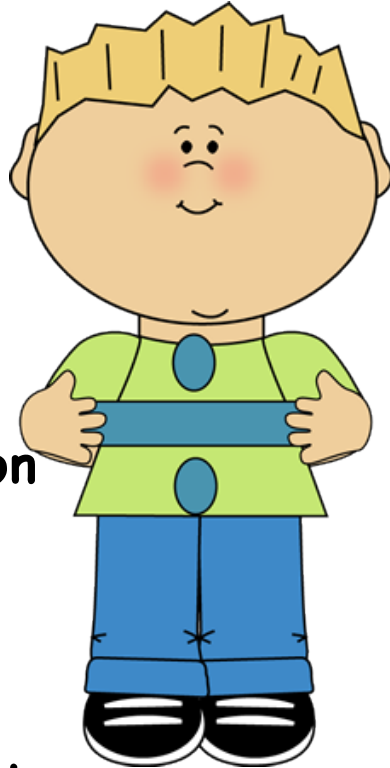
3. There are multiple pages for you to practice your skills! Please have a parent or older sibling mark the first page after you complete it so you know you are on the right track!

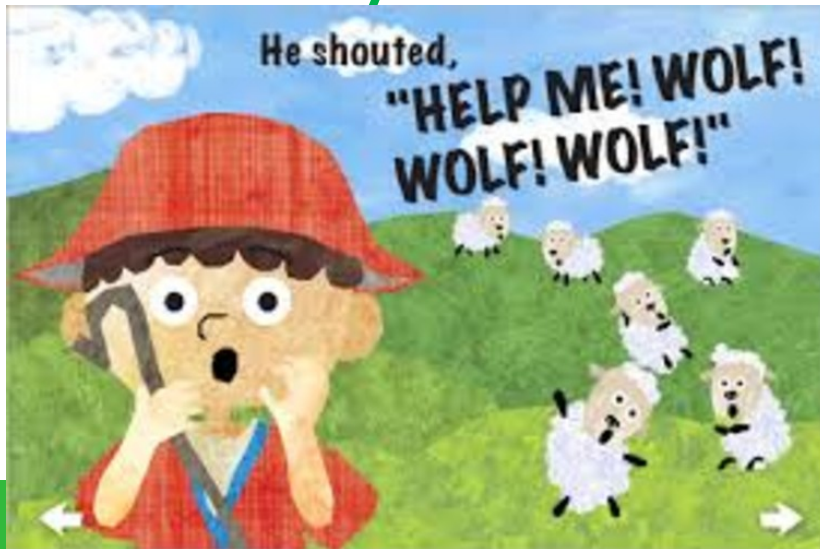
